**SCOPE OF PRACTICE**

Oregon: Denturists construct, repair, reline, reproduce, duplicate, supply, fit or alter removable prosthetic dental appliances, otherwise known as dentures. In the fitting process, denturists also take impressions, bite registrations, try-ins or insertions. Denturists provide full dentures to replace complete sets of original teeth that are missing in the upper, lower or both sections of the mouth, or partial dentures, which fit sections of the mouth in which some of the original teeth remain.

Oregon

Constructing, repairing, relining, reproducing, duplicating, supplying, fitting or altering a denture or other removable nonorthodontic dental appliance intended to be worn in the human mouth in respect of which a service is performed under paragraph (b) of this subsection; and (b) The following services when performed for a purpose listed in paragraph (a) of this subsection:

- (A) The taking of impressions;
- (B) The taking of bite registrations;
- (C) Try-ins of dentures or other removable nonorthodontic dental appliances intended to be worn in the human mouth; and
- (D) Insertions of dentures or other removable nonorthodontic dental appliances intended to be worn in the human mouth.
