### ***WHAT IS A DENTURIST?***

A denturist is the only professional legislated “exclusively” to serve individuals with removable dental prosthetics. The denturist’s entire required curriculum of study focuses on the oral health of those individuals needing a dental prosthetic and the actual fabrication of that appliance. Everyone needing a removable dental appliance should have the privilege to choose this highly trained professional. The goal of the National Denturist Association, USA is to help every citizen have that opportunity to choose.

### ***IS A DENTURIST A DENTIST?***

Denturists and dentists are similar in that both are dental healthcare professionals. Education standards are similar when comparing the sciences in order to serve a patient; however, the denturist’s education emphasizes the technical skills necessary to actually fabricate and serve the patient with a removable dental appliance. There is no necessary outsourcing because the appliance is actually made by the denturist or in his/her facility, whereas, a dentist most often would outsource the impression to a laboratory.

### ***WHY CHOOSE A DENTURIST?***

A denturist is an expert serving patients with removable dental appliances. Their entire curriculum of study involves the necessary sciences involved in serving the patient as well as the technical studies to actually fabricate and serve the patient with the dental appliance.

### ***CAN MY DENTIST PROVIDE PROSTHETICS?***

Many dentists prefer not to involve themselves in serving patients with removable dental appliances and refer those patients to denturists. However, dentists do serve patients with this need and often work closely with a dental laboratory where the appliance is actually fabricated.

### ***HOW DO I KNOW I WILL BE GETTING QUALITY CARE?***

As with any profession the quality of care depends on the provider. Many patients seeking the service of a denturist have been referred by another patient or another professional; denturist, dentist or the patient’s medical doctor. Patients are more than willing to recommend their denturist. Many denturists offer complimentary initial visits in order to become acquainted with a potential patient. You should feel comfortable knowing you are being served by an individual whose education and experience is focused exclusively on your dental prosthetic need.
